Maitri Diwas - Commemorating 50 years of India-Bangladesh Friendship

High Commission of India and High Commission of Bangladesh jointly commemorated on 6 December 2021, the Maitri Diwas, in Australia. Maitri Diwas is observed to commemorate the Golden Jubilee of diplomatic ties between India and Bangladesh and the 50th Anniversary of Bangladesh Liberation War.

During the visit of PM Shri Narendra Modi to Bangladesh in March 2021, to attend the National Day of Bangladesh, it was decided to commemorate 06 December as Maitri Diwas (Friendship Day). Maitri Diwas is a reflection of the deep and abiding friendship between the peoples of India and Bangladesh.

Ms. Harinder Sidhu, Deputy Secretary, Department of Foreign Affairs & Trade joined the event as the Guest of Honour.
